STANDARD PATHWAY, \$149 Complete the six week core course, then apply into weeks 7 to 9. The fee is a \$49 application fee plus \$100 for the three week track.

EXPERIENCE BASED PATHWAY, \$99 Bring at least 1 year of hands on AI work experience and apply directly into weeks 7 to 9. You skip weeks 1 to 6. Every claim is reviewed before approval.

What the three weeks cover

WEEK 7. Department workflow analysis Map every step your department runs, then sort which of those steps AI can take off your people.

WEEK 8. Culture and change diagnostics Read your department's culture with two diagnostics, then produce the one page rollout plan that culture will accept.

WEEK 9. Building and governing agents Scope, build, test, and govern a working AI agent, then defend it in front of your cohort.

What certification requires

- Healthcare management experience
- A passing score on the Q Track assessment
- Annual recertification at \$49.99 per year
- Weeks 1 to 6 first, unless you enter on the experience based pathway

What a Q is, and is not

- A Q is the AI expert inside their own organization
- A Q teaches their own people, in their own building
- A Q does not teach the QuadCo curriculum
- No one has been certified yet. We are building the network now

Before the Q Track

AI for Healthcare Leaders, the six week core course Everyone starts here. Six structured weeks that end in a safe AI pilot you design for your own department, built to be learned in the gaps of your day. The Q Track is the optional continuation, and the core course stands on its own without it.

\$29.99, founding cohort price Holds through September 30, 2026. The price increases October 1, 2026. The first cohort opens September 4, 2026. Before you pay, you can create a free account and take a sample lesson at no cost, so you can judge the material before spending anything.

Fees and refunds. If we decline your Q Track application, we return the \$49 application fee less the card processing fee. That is about \$47.25 back, and it reaches you within 30 days of the decision. That is the only fee QuadCo refunds. The \$99 experience pathway fee is not refundable. Once an approved applicant begins the track, the \$100 track fee is not refundable either, because the work is the review and the track itself. Recertification fees are not refundable once the term starts. If QuadCo moves or cancels a cohort, Section 8.7 of the Terms of Use sets out what you can ask for, and that is not a fee refund. Where this sheet and the Terms of Use could be read differently, the Terms of Use win. Read them at thequadco.ai/terms.
